

Elder Abuse Prevention Program Narrative

Older Americans Act Title VII

Description

The Elder Abuse Prevention, Education and Training's program goal is to conduct public education and training of professionals and caregivers to develop, strengthen, and carry out programs for the prevention, detection, assessment, and treatment of, intervention in, investigation of, and response to elder abuse, neglect and exploitation, including financial exploitation. This includes training for the Title III E caregivers. Allowable activities include, but are not limited to, public education and outreach, coordination of elder abuse prevention services with adult protective services, law enforcement and the court and training.

The Elder Abuse Prevention Educational materials are educational materials and guidance kits that are distributed for the prevention, detection, assessment, and treatment of, intervention in, investigation of, and response to elder abuse, neglect and exploitation, including financial exploitation.

Goal - To improve the protection of older persons who are in danger of abuse, neglect, or exploitation by providing public education, outreach, interagency coordination and abuse investigation.

Benefits of program – The program provides funding to educate the public about how to prevent, recognize, and respond to elder abuse.
